THE GAME: Illinois Wesleyan (3-1 overall, 3-0 College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) continues its 127th football season with the annual Homecoming game against Carthage College (2-2, 2-1 CCIW) with a 1 p.m. kickoff at Tucci Stadium in Bloomington, Ill.

HOMECOMING RECOGNITION: The Illinois Wesleyan football teams that won CCIW championships in 1977, 1992 and 2007 are being recognized at halftime of Saturday's football game. **1977:** The Titans won their last four to finish 6-2 in winning the league... IWU was led by junior All-American RB Kurt Swearingen, junior QB Marty Anderson, and defensive MVP Bob Grimes ... **1992:** The Titans went through the regular season with a 9-0 record and were 1-1 in the NCAA, losing at Mount Union. RB Maury Parker, QB Tom Monken and All-American WR Chris Bisailon were the offensive leaders while LB Rob Zvonar, CB Rich Kozlowski and D.J. Rossini headed the defensive charge ... **2007:** The Titans finished 6-1 in the CCIW and 7-3 overall. RB Marcus Dunlop, QB Kraig Ladd and WR Martin Ceisel were the offensive leaders while LB Nick Nikolich had 94 tackles to lead the defense.

POLLING PLACE: The Illinois Wesleyan football team is at No. 18 (down from No. 19) in the Sept. 30 D3football.com top 25 ... From the CCIW, Wheaton jumped up to No. 13 after beating North Central (who fell to No. 17) ... Mount Union is No. 1, followed by Mary Hardin Baylor, St. Thomas and Brockport ... Illinois Wesleyan remained at No. 21 (second straight week) in the American Football Coaches Assn. poll. Wheaton moved up to No. 17 and North Central is No. 18.

OCTOBER: The Titans are 89-49 (.640 winning mark) in the month during the Norm Eash coaching tenure, including a 4-0 record in 2017 ... IWU was 4-1 in 2016, 4-1 in October 2015, 1-3 in October 2014, 4-0 in October 2013, 2-2 in October 2012, 4-1 in October 2011, 3-2 in October in 2010, 4-1 in October 2009, 2-2 in October 2008 and 4-0 in October 2007.

GAME #1,043 AHEAD: In its 127th season, IWU has an overall 1,042-game record of 588-412-42 (.583 winning percentage) ... Of the 1,042 games, head coach **Norm Eash** has been involved in 344 of them (308 as a coach, 36 as a player from 1971-74) ... Illinois Wesleyan's 35-27 win at Albion on Sept. 13, 2014 was the 1,000th game in Illinois Wesleyan football history.

HOME AND AWAY: Since Norm Eash became head coach in 1987, Illinois Wesleyan is 110-45 (.708) at home and 93-59-1 on the road (.603).

COACH NORM EASH: The “dean” of league coaches and winningest coach in school history, **Norm Eash** (Illinois Wesleyan, 1975) is in his 32nd season at IWU ... He has a career overall record of 203-104-1 (.657) and a career CCIW mark of 145-81-1 (.631) ... The conference win over Wheaton (24-14, Sept. 15, 2018) moved Eash into the all-time lead for the most CCIW coaching victories. He passed his former head coach **Don “Swede” Larson**, who was 142-89-6 in 33 seasons (.612)... Eash became the school’s all-time football coaching win leader with a 52-21 victory over North Park on Oct. 12, 2013 ... He surpassed the record held by his own college coach, **Larson** (168-121-6 from 1954-86) ... Eash has been CCIW “Coach of the Year” six times (2017, 2009, 2007, 2001, 1996, 1992) ... The win at Augustana on Oct. 17, 2009, was Eash’s 100th CCIW win.

LAST WEEK: Junior quarterback **Brandon Bauer (Frankfort, Ill., Lincoln-Way East HS)** threw for one touchdown and ran for two more as Illinois Wesleyan won its third straight College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin game with a 28-13 victory at Carroll University at Schneider Stadium in Waukesha, Wis., on Sept. 29 ... Illinois Wesleyan rolled up 428 yards of total offense with 282 coming in the air and 146 via the rush while limiting Carroll to 287 total yards (147 passing, 140 rushing). IWU claimed 20 first downs to 18 for Carroll and the Titans held a slight edge in possession time with 31:52 to 28:08 ... Bauer completed 23 of 34 passes for 282 yards with a 6-yard touchdown pass to **Bryce Dooley (LeRoy, Ill., LeRoy HS)**. Bauer ran for 33 total yards on 10 carries with TD runs of 3 yards in the second quarter and 4 yards with 14:55 to play in the game that put the Titans ahead 28-7 ... Senior **Morgan Alexander (Elmhurst, York HS)** rushed for 107 yards on 23 carries and had a 5-yard touchdown run in the third quarter that staked IWU to a 21-7 lead ... Junior **Jack Healy (Northfield, Ill., Glenbrook South HS)** made seven catches for 161 yards, including a long reception of 51 yards. Junior **Zach Walsh (Lombard, Glenbard East HS)** made five grabs for 40 yards and Dooley had six receptions for 33 yards ... Defensively, the Titans were led by the 12 tackles (nine solo, three assists) and an interception from junior defensive back **Trevor Koepke (Tinley Park HS)** while senior defensive back **Quintin Walters (Chicago Heights, Ill., Homewood-Flossmoor HS)** had six total tackles with four solo including a quarterback sack. Junior linebacker **Jake Kapp (Wheaton, Montini Catholic HS)**, senior defensive back **Trevor Staley (Lake Zurich HS)** and junior linebacker **Ryan Swift (Brookfield, Ill., Riverside-Brookfield HS)** each contributed five total tackles.

ALEXANDER ON THE RUN: In career rankings, senior RB **Morgan Alexander (Elmhurst, Ill., York HS)** now has 1469 rushing yards, good for No. 19 all-time at IWU. Just ahead of him is Aaron Telford with 1538 (from 1998-2001) and Devonte Jones with 1544 (2011-13).

BAUER'S CAREER: In career rankings, junior QB **Brandon Bauer (Frankfort, Ill., Lincoln-Way East HS)** now has 401 completions in 660 attempts for 4,737 yards, ranking No. 7 in all three categories in IWU history. His career 60.8 completion percentage is third all-time for IWU quarterbacks with a minimum of 100 attempts.

BEHIND ENEMY LINES: Carthage College improved to 2-2 overall and 2-1 in the CCIW with a 63-7 Homecoming win over Elmhurst College at Art Keller Field last Saturday ... Carthage finished with 287 rushing yards and passed for 281 as the Red Men outgained the Bluejays 568-232. The Red Men opened the game up with 35 second quarter points, as a 7-0 lead after the opening 15 minutes turned into a 42-0 blowout at the half ...



Senior Lafayette McGary had career-highs of 25 carries, 179 rushing yards and four touchdowns to power the Red Men offense ... Passing for the Red Men, Billy Dury completed 10 of 13 passes for 193 yards and Colton Klein was four of eight for 69 yards with one TD and a rushing TD. Evan French led Carthage with five catches for 125 yards ... Kameron Stubblefield was named the CCIW Defensive Player of the Week as he made six solo tackles with a career-high three sacks and four tackles for loss. Malik Thigpen and Brett Sullivan each forced a fumble and Emmet Trost and Virgil Young had an interception each ... Lance Unland was 9-for-9 on extra point kicks ... Dustin Hass is in his first season as Carthage head coach after serving as the team's defensive coordinator/defensive backs coach for the past five seasons. A quarterback at Division I Indiana, Hass was a graduate assistant for the Hoosiers for two seasons and was an assistant at Wooster before coming to Carthage.

THE SERIES VS. CARTHAGE (42-20) Home: 23-13, Away: 19-7

THE SERIES VS. CARTHAGE: The Titans lead the series with the Red Men, 42-20, dating back to an Oct. 23, 1926 game in Bloomington. Illinois Wesleyan has won three in a row and nine of the last 11 meetings, and the last Red Men win vs. the Titans was in 2014 in a 20-10 decision in Bloomington ... Prior to that the Red Men last won in 2008 (26-21 also in Bloomington).

CCIW PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Illinois Wesleyan junior wide receiver **Jack Healy (Northfield, Ill., Glenbrook South HS)** was selected as the CCIW Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. Healy totaled 12 catches for 203 yards and touchdown catches of seven, 64 and two yards. His 203 receiving yards is currently the ninth-best mark in school history.

SEPTEMBER: The Titans are 71-23-1 (.745) in the Norm Eash coaching era in the month, including a 3-1 record in 2018 ... IWU was 4-1 in September in 2017 and 2-1 in September 2016 ... The Titans had a 22-game September winning streak ended with the loss at Simpson in 2014 ... The last loss before that was on Sept. 15, 2007 to Mt. St. Joseph... IWU teams won 11 straight September games (all non-league) from 1995 (loss at Simpson) until 2001 (loss to Washington U.).

UNDER THE LIGHTS: Since bringing lights back to Tucci Stadium in 2001, Illinois Wesleyan has a 10-3 home record under the lights... Last week was the 13th home night football game at IWU's Wilder Field since 1971...The Oct. 25, 2008 game was the latest night game on the calendar at home in at least 43 years. In 2002, IWU won its first overtime game in a 31-24 decision over Washington U. The Titans were to have played Aurora at night on Sept. 15, 2001, but the game was cancelled after the national tragedies of Sept. 11. Before 2002, the last home night game was on Oct. 2, 1971, when Carthage downed the Titans, 22-19. Home night game results since 1965:
