•The People's Republic of Angola is a country of 8.9 million people, located in southwest Africa on the Atlantic coast. Its area is 481,000 square miles, larger than Texas and California combined. The chief crops are coffee and bananas, and the industries are food processing, textiles, mining, tires, and petroleum. Angola's government is a Marxist people's republic, one-party rule, with a Russian influence, backed by 25,000 Cubans, East Germans, and Portugese. The official language is Portugese and the country is 68% Roman Catholic.
