

INCREASED HEIGHT BOOSTS TITAN HOPES

Basketball is known as the game of giants, but height is also important in volleyball. Increased height is one reason Coach Kathy Argo believes Illinois Wesleyan's volleyballers are on the comeback trail following an 0-28 mark of 1976, when pre-season personnel losses turned what promised to be a veteran team into a rookie-dominated squad.

"Having more height makes us stronger at the net defensively and should give us more options offensively," said Argo, whose tallest player is 6-foot freshman Becky McCoy. Yvonne Dierks stands 5-9, Sharen Lahti, Terri Naffziger and Jean Worland are 5-8 and Tami Downs and Lu Opperman are 5-7.

Lahti was voted the squad's most improved player last year and is the only senior. With her in the starting lineup at the outset of the season are letterwinners Terri Naffziger and Debbie Rewerts, returning squad member Yvonne Dierks, freshman Marci Anleitner and sophomore Jean Worland.

"Lahti has improved incredibly," said Argo. "She has improved her passing and is much stronger."

THE WOMEN'S ATHLETIC PROGRAM AT IWU
